Awards

Zone 2 Ambassador – A Rider who has shown consistent sportsmanship, encourages and helps other riders and is always well presented

Most Improved Rider – A rider/horse combination that has shown the most improvement, advanced up grades/heights and/or improved by moving up in placing

Best newcomer - Riders that has just started (in that competition year) competing out at official events (in official classes)

Most Helpful Volunteer – A parent or helper that just gets in and helps without being asked

Recognition of Riders who represented Zone 2 at State Level

Rules

1. Rider/Horse combinations must attend the Zone Championship event in that discipline to be eligible for trophy/award;
2. Points are accumulated by Rider/Horse combination therefore a rider may be eligible twice if they ride two horses;
3. Points from Official events and classes (Including Zone Championships) in Zone 2 only;
4. Point collected during the competition year from 1 February - 31 October only;
5. Rider must have attended a minimum of 2 musters during the year;
6. The results will be accumulated from the Official published results on the Zone 2 website;
7. Perpetuals will not be taken home and will remain at Oxenford Pony Club;
8. Each perpetual will have two winners (12 years & under, and 13 & under 26 years);
9. If a rider turns 13 during the competition year they will be placed in the age bracket they have achieved the majority of their competition points; and
10. If a rider turns 26 during the competition year their points will count up until their 26th birthday.
