grounds prior to competing.

Canteen: Full canteen available each day

Photography: Professional photography both days

Conditions of Competition

- Showjumping Performance Cards, complete with details of date, venue and classes, along with Horse Health Declarations must be handed to the Event Secretary.
- Riders may enter 2 horses in same height for Jumping Equitation
- Showjumping Riders may enter 2 horses in the same or different heights.
- Each horse may gain qualifying results.
- Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.
- Seniors Can ride in any of the heights from Official & Unofficial sections. Must choose from Official Classes: 1 to 6 (Showjumping) to be eligible for overall Senior award. If they do not choose a height when nominating they will be placed in the 80cm class. Seniors will ride with the group and be placed as if part of the group. Points will be recorded separately so as not take a place from riders under 26.
- Classes cannot be changed on the day.
- All riders will be required to provide a helper. Riders may be eliminated if an allocated "job" is not completed.
- Protests: Should be lodged within 30 minutes of the results being posted, or the incident and accompanied by a \$50.00 fee which is refundable only if protest is upheld.
- Cancellation Fees (10% of Entry) apply to all withdrawals.
- Withdrawals within 4 days of event will not be refunded unless request supplied with signed and

dated Vet certificate stating reason for withdrawal.

 Stable Bond of \$20 applied will be applied on nominating and will be refunded if stable left clean on departure. (Free of hay, manure and wet sawdust)

2022 PCQ Rules apply to all events. PCQ Code of Conduct will be in effect. Bad language, excessive striking of horse, abuse or disrespect to any official will result in disqualification.

RESERVATION OF RIGHT

The organizers reserve the right to:

- a) Cancel any Class or event
- b) Divide any class
- c) Alter the advertised times
- d) Refuse entry, with or without stating a reason
- e) Transfer competitors between sections of a class
- f) Combine Class if less than 3 competitors
